- 3. Treasurer's Report Informational
 - a. Per Commissioner Kohn, SCWG has spent nearly \$4,000 for the Birth Justice event.
 - b. MOU Draft: The Commissioners reviewed the revised draft of the MOU. Commissioner Thomas made a motion to approve the draft and Commissioner/Dr. Thomas made a motion to second the MOU draft. Chair Hamilton will provide the FSCWG with updated draft. FSCWG will meet next Wednesday, June 21 to review the MOU.
- 4. Membership Update (VC/Commissioner Lemos)

For the vacant Commissioner at Large position, there are 3 candidates interested and the interviews are scheduled for next Thursday, June 22 from 6:00PM-8:00PM. There are 6 Commissioners who are available to participate in the interview process. Prep time for the Commissioners is from 6:00PM-6:15PM. Recommendations will be brought to the full commission in August 2023. Chair Hamilton is working on reaching out to the City of Fairfield as interviews are taking place. The hope is to also have a Commissioner from Fairfield to join SCWG.

VC/Commissioner Lemos will share with the Youth Commission about the openings for the Youth Commissioner position. One youth who is a Junior in High School is interested in the Youth Commission position.

- 5. Period Project 2023 Update (Chair Sanchez)
- a. Period Project First meeting was held on Monday, June 5 went well. The donation letter and press release are in the works. In addition, a grant letter request is in being

formulated. Next meeting is scheduled for Monday, July 3. However, due to the holiday, consensus is to move the meeting a week ahead to Monday, June 26.

- 6. Future Planning (Chair Hamilton)
- a. October 2023 Event 5th Anniversary looking at venues, not expensive. Needs to check in with FSCWG for collaboration. This project is not project-driven, but celebration and getting publicity.
- b. Workshop with SCWG and FSCWG Discussion to collaborate on a joint workshop in the Fall.
- 7. Updates from Chair Hamilton: SCWG is dark in July 2023.

Guest Helena Chung brought up the idea about bringing up an expert to discuss about fentanyl poisonings and she suggests reaching out to Drug Safe Solano. Commissioner Nicodemus strongly recommended bringing in the experts to discuss and also conduct Narcan training. VC/Commissioner Lemos agreed with Commissioner Nicodemus. Commissioner Nicodemus shared about a program called Freedom Equine Connection that is based in Dixon and suggested inviting an Equine Assisted Therapist and Learning Specialist who connects horse therapy with troubled individuals to a meeting. Commissioner Nicodemus has contacted the Executive Director Denise Wilson and hopes to invite her to a later Commission meeting.

8. Commissioner Comments:

Congratulations to Commissioner Thomas on starting her own consultant company. Commissioner/VC Lemos will with the Commissioners about an article on Women empowerment.

9. Reception for outgoing Commissioner Sofia Cruz who is heading to New York to further her education in public health. Commissioners bid Commissioner Cruz farewell and urged her to keep in contact.
